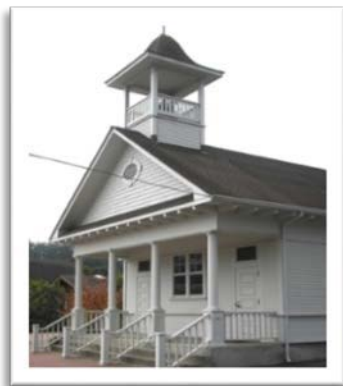

Public Pre-school Program for 4-Year Olds

The Bolinas-Stinson Union School District is now registering students for a new public preschool program for 4- year olds that is scheduled to open in August of 2017.

This program will be free of charge to families residing in the district and there may be additional room for students who live in neighboring school districts.

This preliminary registration* period will open on October 23 and will close on November 21.

The program will open only if there are sufficient numbers of students whose families are committed to enrolling them. One of the reasons that the district is accepting early registrations is to assess the number of students who will actually attend next fall.

If you wish to register your child (who will be 4 years old by September 1, 2017) please be ready to provide the following information:

- The child's name
- The child's date of birth
- The child's place of residence- the address where the child sleeps most nights.
- The name of the parent or guardian.

If the program opens next year as planned, additional registration materials will be required.

* Early registration is very important but does not guarantee that your child will be enrolled when the program opens.

Maintenance II

Under the direction of the Superintendent and/or Principal, performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled work in several areas of the building trades in order to repair and maintain assigned buildings, equipment and facilities operated by the District.

In addition to all responsibilities assigned to the position of Maintenance Worker I, employees in this class are expected to coordinate schedules, work cooperatively with employees in similar classes, and maintain an overall perspective of the maintenance needs of the district.

The employee in classification of Maintenance Worker II will be expected to develop, with assistance, a data base of maintenance projects and to provide input for their prioritization. Perform basic duties in several specialized areas of the building trades to include carpentry, electrical and plumbing.

Bus Driver II

Under general supervision, assists in coordinating the District's student transportation program, operate a school bus over designated routes to transport school children; assists in the general cleaning and servicing of school buses; may be assigned to special trips out of District or to other special designated places in the District. Bus Drivers are expected to keep the assigned bus clean and assist with its preventive maintenance.

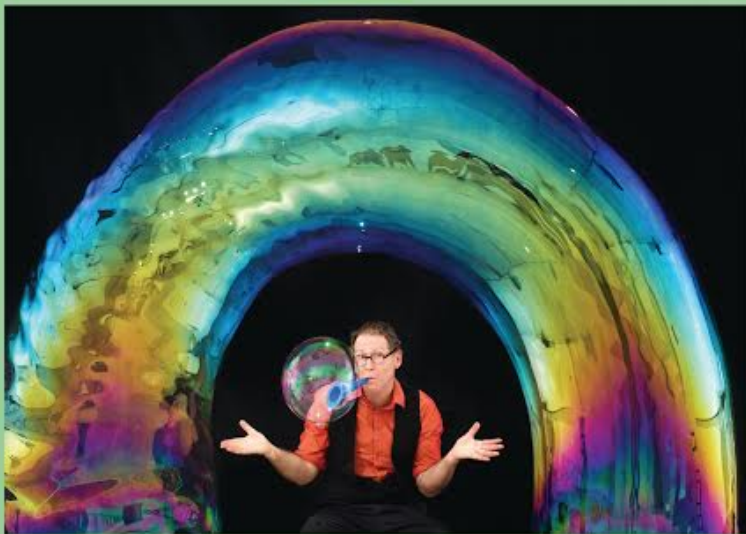
