Snack: Yogurt & granola/oatmeal, hard boiled eggs, fruit, milk

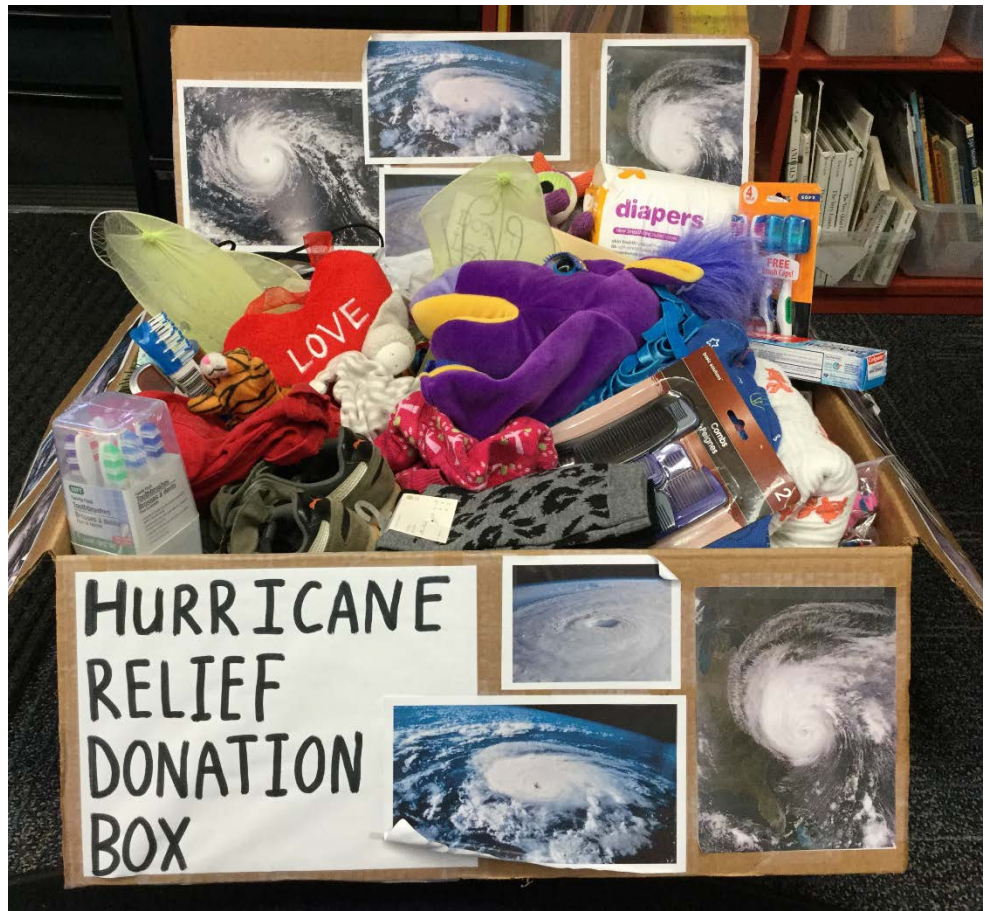

- Your most recent work permit
- 2 passport-sized photos
- A check or money order for \$495
(made out to "U.S. Department of Homeland Security")
- A list of all the addresses where you have lived in 2015, 2016 and 2017. For each address, write down the year and month you moved in.
- Your Social Security Number
(just the number -- the actual card is not needed)
- A past DACA application or renewal application.
- If you have been outside the US in the last 2 years: Bring your passport.
