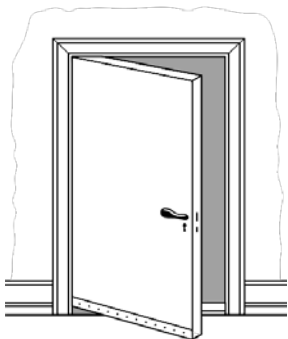

Bolinas Stinson Summer Camp Registration NOW OPEN!

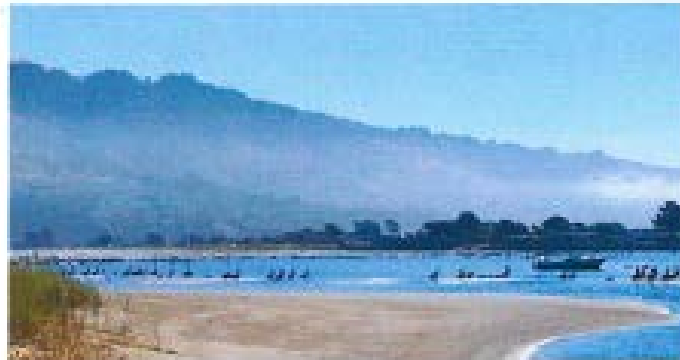
