Hello BSUSD Board Members & Administration & Staff:

Attached are:

1. Summarized survey results for the FOFAC Survey of BSUSD staff
2. Excel digest of all questions (includes a comment tally)

We achieved an 80% respondent rate, which is incredible.

In broad strokes, many areas received a SATISFACTORY rating overall.

Facility Areas designated as NEEDING IMPROVEMENT (highlighted in yellow on Excel)

1. Quesada- 7 out of 8 aspects were rated as needing improvement at significantly high percentages (most over 60%; functionality & acoustics=78%)
2. Technology (Hardware= 64%; Student Devices= 59%; Classroom=50%)
3. Parking (Parents & Public- 52%; Staff=72% Satisfactory)
4. Administration Areas (Storage=56%; Meeting Space= 50%; Privacy= 41/41%)
5. Storage: Admin (56%), Classrooms (Teacher= 55%), PE (55%), Custodial (32%)
6. General Program Considerations (Space Flexibility= 50%)
7. Utilities- Cable & Intercoms (50/50%)
8. Kitchen: Equipment (56%); Kitchen (48%)
9. Art Shop- Wood (42%)& Metal (47%)
10. Support Services (43%)

Facility Areas designated as NON-EXISTENT (highlighted in pink on Excel)

1. Nurse/Sick Children Area (65%)
2. Gymnasium (65%)
3. Drama/Performing Arts Space (NE=35%; NI=30%)
4. Intercom Communication System (55%; global or all-campus)
5. Teacher Lounge/Dining (NI=33%/NE=24%)
6. Teacher Work Room (41%)

Questions 30-36 are open-ended. I attempted to tabulate answers by subject & include all comments (except where it made sense to amalgamate responses).

There is a lot of interest/enthusiasm for:

1. Gymnasium/Performing Arts Space (AKA "Multi-Use Facility")
2. Science Lab
3. Tech Lab (changes/improvements)
4. Outdoor Classroom

I extend a HUGE "thank you" to BSUSD staff for taking time to complete this survey.

I hope the results bear fruit in terms of meeting the needs of our staff, which ultimately will hopefully better meet the educational needs of our children thus positioning them for a lifetime of success in the 21st Century.
